Your Directors are pleased to present the quarterly report for the period ended December 31, 2006.

Sharp drop in sugar prices due to offloading of sugar stocks by the government has had a negative impact on profitability. The crushing season commenced on 30th November, 2006. However, low sugar prices prevail and cane arrivals at mills are slow due to growers' expectations of higher cane prices later in the season.

The Directors project a short term glut of sugar in the early half of the year with prices improving in the later half.

NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE QUARTER ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2006

1 THE COMPANY AND ITS OPERATIONS

The Company is incorporated in Pakistan and listed on the Karachi and Lahore Stock Exchanges. The principal activity of the Company is manufacturing and selling of sugar and its by-products.

2 COMPLIANCE WITH STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of International Accounting Standard (IAS) 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" and are being submitted to the shareholders as required U/S 245 of the Companies Ordinance, 1984.

3 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies adopted for preparation of these financial statements are the same as adopted for the preceding annual published financial statements of the Company.

4 SEASONALITY OF THREE MONTHS OPERATIONS

Due to the seasonal availability of sugarcane, the manufacturing of sugar is carried out during the period of availability of sugarcane and costs incurred up to the reporting date have been accounted for.

5 CONTINGENCIES AND COMMITMENTS

5.1 Contingencies

There were no known quantifiable contingencies as on December 31, 2006.

5.2 Commitments

Commitments in respect of capital expenditure were Rs.130.79 million.

6 DATE OF AUTHORIZATION OF ISSUE

These financial statements were authorized for issue by the Board of Directors on January 25, 2007.

7 GENERAL

Figures have been rounded off to the nearest thousand rupees.

Corresponding figures have been rearranged wherever necessary for comparison purposes. However, no material reclassification has been made.
